**Animal Welfare Policy**  
Kumaun University, Nainital

**Introduction**

Kumaun University, Nainital, recognizes the importance of promoting animal welfare within its campus premises. This policy outlines the university's commitment to ensuring the well-being of various animals inhabiting its campus, including monkeys, langurs, birds, leopards, dogs, and cats.

**Objectives**

- To provide a safe and healthy environment for animals within the university campus.
- To prevent animal cruelty and promote compassionate treatment of animals.
- To manage conflicts between humans and animals in a humane and sustainable manner.

**Awareness and Education:** The university will organise awareness campaigns, workshops, and educational programs to promote understanding and respect for animal welfare among students, faculty, and staff.

### **Specific Measures for Animal Species**
