

Agenda

Item No.1.The syllabus of the MSW course was considered by board of study. After through deliberations, suggested the changes in the various papers of MSW course. The syllabus with changes are being attached herewith for the approval of the higher bodies of the university.

Item No.2 Ordinances and Regulations of MSW course was discussed with special reference to ordinance No.5;Eligibility for admission to MSW Course: Since IInd division bachelors degree is being awarded in Uttarakhand State having 45% and above marks as IInd Division therefore its recommended that eligibility for admission to MSW course be 45% or above rather than 50% and above.SC/ST category students shall be allowed to have 5% relaxation in the eligibility requirement of MSW course for admission.



Item No.3 Since the MSW course was started in the academic session 2014-15 ,under self finance basis, which has successfully complete one year and the second batch admissions have been completed for the academic session 2015-16.It is therefore proposed that an independent Department of Social Work be opened in University. For this purpose necessary action should be taken by the university to create the Department of Social Work as an independent Department in the University as it is very beneficial and demanded by the large member of students of state. The Board recommends that the necessary funds should be provided to establish this Department on regular basis as per UGC norms following posts be created to run this course.





It has been decided to construct the courses on the basis of changing the need of the society to expertise in the particular field, therefore, students get specialization to do work in the society. Optional courses ^{at P.G. level} should be prepared in such a manner so that students have continuous knowledge from first ^{semester} to the last semester in the same specialized field. This may be related to Medical Sociology, Sociology of Communication, Sociology of Deviances, Sociology of Management etc. These courses will be helpful to the students to get job in the society.

3. The board also decided to introduce the paper related to Action Sociology particularly '**Sociology of Sanitation**'. This type of course would be helpful in changing the structure and function of society.
4. Evaluation process of semester exam will be in two parts-
 - a- Internal Assessment
 - b- Written exam
5. The distribution of marks for internal assessment and written papers will be decided as per university ordinance.
6. For recommending the panel for paper setters and examiners for forthcoming semester and annual examination, convener BOS/RDC has been authorized.









Agenda Item: Syllabus revision for CBCS Pattern in the M.A. Programme/course of Sociology for the Session 2020-21 onwards [In the light of letter no. (i) DIC/2020/CBCS/ 272, dt. 04.07.2020/CBCS/487 (ii)/Manyate/2404, dt. 19-12-2020 (iii) DIC/2020/CBCS/487, dt. 24.12.2020].

The draft of revised course structure/syllabus as per CBCS pattern for Postgraduate programme/semesters of Sociology, updated and revised as directed by the university (vide letter no. Affl. /BOS / Sociology / 2020/2429, dt. 28.12.2020), was put up before the Board and discussed at length. The members made several suggestions to improve upon the draft syllabus, which included the following -

1. The nomenclature of Paper-1 in M.A. Second semester - 'Indian Sociological Thinkers' may be modified as 'Indian Sociological Thoughts'.
2. In Paper-1 of M.A. Semester-1, that is 'Classical Sociological Thinkers', the thinkers should be arranged in a chronological order.
3. The referencing of all recommended books in all papers should be done in chronological order and in proper manner. Some latest book should be introduced in all papers.
4. Supplementary list of latest books may be added at the earliest.

Resolution: The Board of Studies resolved to approve the finalized structure and syllabus of the MA course in Sociology for implementation from the academic session 2020-21 onwards. Moreover, the Board authorized the convener to make changes in the pattern of questions papers, if required, as and when directed by the university. The Board authorized the Convener to suggest the panel of Examiners for the Examination till the next meeting of the Board of studies (Sociology).




