The university's commitment to holistic development was evident through health-focused programs and camps such as:

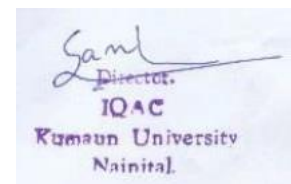
- **Cervical Cancer Awareness:** Workshops and health camps were organized to educate female students and staff about early detection and prevention of cervical cancer.
