BOARD OF STUDIES IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION


In the meeting all the points of the agenda as described below were discussed in details along with the necessary modification and suggestion:


1. Agenda 1. Guidelines for Internal and External evaluation


All the members of the Board have gone through the guidelines for internal and external evaluation and decided that the internal evaluation will carry 15 marks out of which 10marks for written test and 05 marks for attendance. The marks will be given by the concerned teacher. Written test will be consist of 6 questions of 2 marks covering the syllabus student will attempt any 5 questions. **Marks for attendance:** (1) - 95%-100%- 05marks, (2)- 90%-94%- 04marks, (3)- 85%-89%- 03marks, (4)- 80%-84 %- 02marks, (5)- 75%-79%-01marks.


- The distribution of marks in both theory and practical papers shall be 30% in internal and 70% in external evaluation.
- The candidate must obtain score 36% marks in external and internal exams separately.


The external question paper will carry 35 marks and will be of 3 hrs. duration. It will consist of two sections 'A' and 'B'. Section 'A' will consist of 07 short answers type questions each 04 marks each and candidates will be required to attempt any five questions. Section 'B' will be consist 04 long answer type questions of 7.5 marks each and candidates will be required to attempt any two questions.



The external practical exam will carry 35 marks The Marks of Activities will be awarded on the basis of following distribution i.e. Skill Performance related to activity, Practical file, Project work, Viva –voce.

- The internal evaluation will carry 15 marks, out of which 10 marks for skill performance and project work related to activity, Practical file, Project work, Viva –voce and 05 marks for attendance. It will be given by concerned teacher.
- **Marks for attendance:** (1) - 95%-100%- 05marks, (2)- 90%-94%- 04marks, (3)- 85%-89%- 03marks, (4)- 80%-84 %- 02marks, (5)- 75%- 79%-01marks

Agenda 2. Rules for promotion

All the members of the Board have gone through the rules for promotion and decided that:A candidate may still be promoted to the next semester/year where the result of such candidate has been declared as “Carry Over Paper” due to failed in maximum Two (02) papers in a Semester.

- A candidate with COP is entitled to re-appear in external/ internal/ practical examination or in examination for any other component of a paper in whichever he/she has failed.
- Examination for the Carry Over Paper (COP) of odd and Even Semester of a study program shall be held in the respective odd and even Semester examinations of the succeeding year.


- In case of COP in Practical / Viva - Voce examination due to absence or otherwise, he/she will be considered as fail and will repeat the examination with previous students.
- A candidate may be permitted to reappear in any carry over paper along with the main examinations of the concerned semester until the expiry of maximum N+2 years time limit of the course.
- In the case of semester back, the student shall be appear as *ex-student* in the examination for all prescribed papers (External/Internal/Practical examinations) of respective semester.
- Special Back Paper Examination facility will be provided only for second to last semester.





- 36% and above but less than 48% : Third Division





Agenda 4 Criteria for entrance examination

The total entrance test will be of 100 marks consisting three parts- 1. One Physical Fitness Test (modified American Alliance for Health Physical Education and Recreation (AAHPER) fitness test) of 42 marks will be conducted by committee of Internal Examiners. 2. Sports participation weightage of 48 marks shall be given as per the norms laid down by the department. 3. Interview of 10 marks will be conducted by committee of internal examiners. Admission of Physically challenged/ differently abled candidates of any category is not permissible as candidates of this subject are required to perform sports activities.

Note:

- If the Physical fitness test would not be conducted due to pandemic for the session 2020-21 then the board of members decided that weightage will be given on the basis of percentage of high-school and Intermediate examinations.

5. Paper of Environment Science

- The student would undertake a University examination in Environmental studies in the Second Semester and this would be a “qualifying examination” only.
- Minimum 30% marks would be qualified. Grade A+ >75%, Grade A >60%, Grade B >=45%, Grade C >=30%.
