Microbiology course of Kumaun University as under.

I will be thankful if you kindly approve the details of the working ordinances.

### Working Ordinances

1. The Course: M.Sc. (Microbiology) Course is a two years Postgraduate course which shall run under the Faculty of Science and comprise of four semesters. After successful completion of the course, the candidate shall be awarded the degree of M.Sc. (Microbiology).

2. Eligibility: Candidates with Bachelor's degree under 10+2+3 pattern of education in Biological or Physical science, with at least 50% marks, are eligible to be considered for admission to the course. B.Sc. final year students can also appear.

### 3. Admission:

(a) The admission to the course shall be made through merit basis or Entrance Examination conducted by Kumaun University, Nainital

(b) There shall be 40 seats for this course. Reservation will be as per State Govt. rules.

### 4. Course Structure:

(A) The entire course shall be spread over four semesters. Each semester shall ordinarily be of 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  months duration, including examination period.

(B) New course currriculumn approved by the BOS will be followed from 2017-18. In first three semesters the student shall complete all the theory courses (each carrying 100 marks) and related practicals. The IV semester has been kept apart for project work only.

5. Attendance: Any student, who has not attended at least 75% theory and practical classes separately in the current semester, shall not be allowed to appear in the end-semester examination. The college/ university however may condone not more than 10% shortages in attendance in each subject for any of the following reasons.

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- external examiners, shall be moderated by semor faculty memoers.
- (d) The minimum pass marks in theory papers as well as in Practicals separately shall be 40%. The marking and result pattern will be as under.

- (e) A candidate shall be promoted to the next semester if he/she has essentially passed the Laboratory course, and has also passed all theory papers of the concerning semester. If, however, a candidate has failed in not more than two theory papers in a semester, promotion shall be granted to him/her to the next semester but with the condition that he/she will clear (pass) the papers of the earlier semester during the end semester examinations of the very next relevant semester. If, however a candidate fails in the back paper(s) he/she will be allowed to appeared in special back paper in one subject only and that too once only during his/her entire M.Sc. Programme.Without clearing the earlier papers, next promotion shall not be granted. Further, if a candidate is not granted promotion twice in continuation, he/she will be removed from the course.
- (f) In addition to the end-semester examination, the students shall be continuously assessed and warned about their deficiencies through internally arranged periodical tests and home assignments.

Biotechnology course of Kumaun University as under.

## **Revised Ordinances**

**1. The Course:** M.Sc. (Biotechnology) Course is a two years Postgraduate course which shall run under the Faculty of Science and comprise of four semesters. After successful completion of the course, the candidate shall be awarded the degree of M.Sc. (Biotechnology).

**2.** Eligibility: Candidates with Bachelor's degree under 10+2+3 pattern of education in Biological or Physical science, with at least 55% marks, are eligible to be considered for admission to the course.

### 3. Admission:

A. In the department of Biotechnology, Kumaun University, Bhimtal Campus, Bhimtal the admission to the course shall be made through All India Combined Entrance Examination conducted by Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi, whereas in the affiliated colleges/institutes of Kumaun University admissions will be done either by their own entrance or merit basis.

B. For admission to the course, same reservation rules as prescribed by JNU, New Delhi for the combined Entrance Examination shall be applicable.

### 4. Course Structure:

(A) The entire course shall be spread over four semesters. Each semester shall ordinarily be of 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  months duration, including examination period.

(B) The Course Curriculum provided by DBT has been implemented from 2017-18 batch with a little modification. In first three semesters the students shall complete all the theory courses (each carrying 100 marks) and related practicals. The IV semester has been kept apart for project work only.

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5. Attendance: Any student, who has not attended at least 75% theory and practical classes separately in the current semester, shall not be allowed to appear in the end-semester examination. The college/ university however may condone not more than 10% shortage in attendance in each subject for any of the following reasons.

a) Participation in NSS/NCC/Rover Ranger camps

b) Participation in University/Inter-University/State level games

c) Participation in other extra-curricular activities at University/Inter-University/State level.

d) Prolonged illness.

Such relaxation shall only be granted on submission of certificate/evidence from appropriate authority.

#### 6. Evaluation and Promotion:

a) For each end-semester examination there will be external as well as internal assessment in each theory paper. 25 Marks will be for internal assessment (20+5). The theory examination for external paper of each subject will be of 75 marks.

b) The Practical examinations shall be conducted jointly by the external and internal examiners (150 marks each semester).

c) To maintain uniformity in the standard of various theory papers, the papers set by external examiners shall be moderated by senior faculty members.

d) The minimum pass marks in theory papers as well as in Practicals separately shall be 40%. The marking and result pattern has been changed from grade system (as earlier) to division system as under.

e) A candidate shall be promoted to the next semester if he/she has essentially passed the Laboratory course, and has also passed all theory papers of the concerning semester. If, however, a candidate has failed in not more than two theory papers in a semester, promotion shall be granted to him/her to the next semester but with the condition that he/she will clear (pass) the papers of the earlier semester during the end semester examinations of the very next relevant semester. If, however a candidate fails in the back paper(s) he/she will be allowed to appeared in special back paper in one subject only and that too once only during his/her entire M.Sc. Programme. Without clearing the earlier papers, next promotion shall not be granted. Further, if a candidate is not granted promotion twice in continuation, he/she will be removed from the course.

f) In addition to the end-semester examination, the students shall be continuously assessed and warned about their deficiencies through internally arranged periodical tests and home assignments.





Biotechnology course of Kumaun University as under I will be thankful if you kindly approve the details of the revised ordinances

#### **Revised Ordinances**

1. The Course: B.Sc. (Biotechnology) Course is a three years undergraduate course which shall run under the Faculty of Science and comprise of six semesters. After successful completion of the course, the candidate shall be awarded the degree of B.Sc. (Biotechnology).

2. Eligibility: Candidates must have passed 10+2 examination from any recognized board of secondary education scoring at least 40% marks in aggregate of the four subjects (English, Physics, Chemistry & Biology).

3. Admission: Admission will be made on merit basis by different affiliated institutes running this programme. Reservation rules for the admission will be the same as for other B.Sc. courses of Kumaun University, Nainital. The rules pertaining to admission would be implemented from the session 2021-22.

#### 4. Course Structure:

(A) The entire course shall be spread over six semester. Each semester shall ordinarily be of 4 1/2 months duration, including examination period.

(B) In each semester, the student shall complete three theory courses (each earrying 50 marks) and related practicals.

5. Attendance: Any student, who has not attended at least 75% theory and practical classes separately in the current semester, shall not be allowed to appear in the end-semester examination. The Head/ Principal may however may condone not more than 10% shortage in attendance in each subject for any of the following reasons.

- Participation in NSS/NCC/Rover Ranger camps (a)
- Participation in University /Inter-University/State level games (b)
- Participation in other extra- curricular activities at University/Inter-(c) University/State Level.
- (d) Prolonged illness.

Note: 1. A students can avail of this relaxation only on any one of the above grounds. Further, such relaxation can be granted only on submission of certificate/evidence from appropriate authority.

2 Students participating in RDC/PRD may be exempted from the above provisions along with those covered under specific government orders.

6. Medium of instruction and Examination: The medium of teaching and examination shall be English or as otherwise specified by the respective Board of Studies.

## 7. Maximum period for Completion of the Course:

Maximum period allowed to a candidates for completion of UG Program,/PG Program will be n+2, where 'n' would be the normal duration (in year) of an academic programme.

#### 8. Examination

8.1 There will be an examination of theory subjects, practical and projects/dissertation conducted by the University at the end of each semester.

8.3 For each theory subject taught during a semester, there will be one end semester examination (of 3 hours duration) and at least two sessional tests (of not less than 1 hour duration). Following shall be the breakup of marks:

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i) Regularity and disciplineii) Sessional Tests

- 2) (1) A Practical examination based on the theory subjects shall be conducted jointly by the internal and external examiners (50 marks) at the end of the semester. Who are appointed as University norms. In case of absence of suitable internal examiner in the institute the examiner for that subject will be arranged from the University.
- (3) To maintain uniformity in the standard of theory papers, the papers set by external examiners, shall be moderated by senior faculty members.
- (4) A candidate shall be promoted to the next semester if he/she has essentially passed the Laboratory course, and has also passed all theory papers of the concerning semester. If, however, a candidate has failed in not more than one theory papers in a semester, promotion shall be granted to him/her to the next semester but with the condition that he/she will clear (pass) the papers of the earlier semesters during the end semester examinations of the very next relevant semester. Without clearing the earlier papers, next promotion shall not be granted. Further, if a candidate is not granted promotion twice in continuation, he/she will be removed from the course.
- (5) The Department shall conduct three sessional examination in each theory subject. The average of the best two shall contribute to the final result. No chance for improvement of sessional marks would be given.
- (6) In order to be declared successful in B.Sc. (Biotechnology) examination, a candidate shall have to clear all norms of attendance, sessional examination, semester examination, and any other requirements laid down by the department/university.

- (7) A student who fails to pay fee or any other outsanding dues or return library books may not be allowed to appear in final examination.
- (9) In order to pass an examination, an examinee shall obtain:
  - a) Not less than 40% marks in each theory paper including the marks obtained in regularity and sessional examination.
  - b) Not less than 40% marks in each practical paper including the marks obtained in regularity and sessional examination.
  - c) Not less than 40% marks in aggregate of all theory and practical paper including the marks obtained in regularity and sessional examination.
- 8.4 In the case of semester back, the student would appear as ex-students and has to appear in all paper (external/internal/practical examinations) of respective semester.
- 8.5 Student with Carry Over Paper (COP) need to appear in the paper which ever he/she fails.

#### 9. Promotion rules:

9.1 Those students who satisfy their condition of clause 8.2 above results will be declared as 'Pass'' in their mark sheet and shall be promoted to the next semester.

**9.2** When number of papers (theory) in a semester in less than 4. A candidate can be allowed to appear in maximum 01 back paper at a time in a semester. When number of papers (theory) in a semester is equal to or more than 4, a candidate can be allowed to appear in maximum 02 back papers at a time in a semester. Their result will be declared as "Carry Over Paper (COP)"

9.3 The even and odd semester back paper examination will be held in even and odd semester examination respectively.

9.4 Only one opportunity would be provided to clear the back papers.

**9.5** Those candidates who do not satisfy clause 9.1 and 9.2 their result will be declared as "Fail" and students will have semester back.

#### 10. Special Back Paper Examination:

Special Back paper examination facility will be provided only for final/last year papers (second-to-last semester)

#### 11 Result and Award of Division:

11.1 At the end of last semester, successful candidates will be awarded division and degree on the basis of total marks obtained (combined result) of all the semester put together as under:

a) 75% and above. First division and distinction (To be awarded to only those candidates who pass all semester examination in only one attempt)

- b) 60% and above but less than 75% : First Division
- c) 50% and above but less than 59.99%: Second Division d) 40 % and above but less than 49.99%: Third Division
- e) Below 40%: Fail

### 12. Course in Environmental studies:

- 12.1 Undergraduate Programmed where Environmental Science is not compulsory paper in any semester there the students would undertake a university examination in Environmental Studies in the second semester which would be qualifying examination.

In accordance with Kumaun University letter no. Affl./BOS/ Biotechnology/ 2021/2684 dated 22/03/2021 the committee framed by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Kumaun University met today, the 03<sup>rd</sup> April 2021 and after due consideration framed the working ordinances for M.Sc. Biotechnology course of Kumaun University as under

I will be thankful if you kindly approve the details of the revised ordinances.

#### **Revised Ordinances**

1. The Course: M.Sc. (Biotechnology) Course is a two years Postgraduate course which shall run under the Faculty of Science and comprise of four semesters. After successful completion of the course, the candidate shall be awarded the degree of M.Sc. (Biotechnology).

2. Eligibility: Candidates with Bachelor's degree as per university 10+2+3 pattern of education in Biological or Physical science, including BMLT, B.Sc. Biotechnology, B.Sc. Microbiology, B.Tech Biotechnology or related degree programme, with at least 50% marks, are eligible to be considered for admission to the course.

#### 3. Admission:

A) The admission to the course shall be made through merit basis or entrance examination conducted by Kumaun University, Nainital.

B) There shall be 40 seats for this course; Reservation will be as per State Govt. rules.

C) The rules pertaining to admission would be implemented from session 2021-22.

#### 4. Course Structure:

(A) The entire course shall be spread over four semesters. Each semester shall ordinarily be of 4 1/2 months duration, including examination period.

(B) New course curriculumn approved by the BOS will be followed from 2021-22. In first three semesters the student shall complete all the theory courses (each carrying 100 marks) and related practicals. The IV semester has been kept for project work only.

5. Attendance: Any student, who has not attended at least 75% theory and practical classes separately in the current semester, shall not be allowed to appear in the end-semester examination. The college/ university however may condone not more than 10% shortage in attendance in each subject for any of the following reasons.

a) Participation in NSS/NCC/Rover Ranger camps

b) Participation in University/Inter-University/State level games

e) Participation in other extra-curricular activities at University/Inter-University/State level.

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#### d) Prolonged illness.

Note: 1. A students can avail of this relaxation only on any one of the above grounds. Further, such relaxation can be granted only on submission of certificate/evidence from appropriate authority.

Students participating in RDC/PRD may be exempted from the above provisions along with those covered under specific government orders.

6. Medium of instruction and Examination: The medium of teaching and examination shall be English.

## 7. Maximum period for Completion of the Course:

Maximum period allowed to a candidates for completion of the course will be n+2, where 'n' would be the normal duration (in year) of an academic programme.

#### 8. Examination

8.1 There will be an examination of theory subjects, practical and projects/dissertation conducted by the University at the end of each semester.

8.2 To pass in a paper, the candidate should score minimum 40% marks in theory paper and also separately in practical/project/dissertation/viva-voce etc.

**8.3** 25% of the maximum marks in each paper shall be assigned for internal assessment and the remaining 75% marks of the annual/semester University Examination. The practical exam shall be conducted jointly be external and internal examiners (150 marks each semester).

8.4 In the case of semester back, the student would appear as ex-students and has to appear in all paper (external/internal/practical examinations) of respective semester.
8.5 Student with Corres Down (COM)

8.5 Student with Carry Over Paper (COP) need to appear in the paper which ever he/she fails.

**8.6** To maintain uniformity in the standard of various theory papers, the paper set by external examiners shall be moderated by settior faculty members.

8.7 In addition to the end semester examination, the students shall be continuously assessed and informed about their deficiencies through internally arranged periodical test and home assignments.

#### 9. Promotion rules:

9.1 Those students who satisfy their condition of clause 8.2 above results will be declared as 'Pass' in their mark sheet and shall be promoted to the next semester.

9.2 When number of papers (theory) in a semester in less than 4. A candidate can be allowed to appear in maximum 01 back paper at a time in a semester. When number of papers (theory) in a semester is equal to or more than 4, a candidate can be allowed to appear in maximum 02 back papers at a time in a semester. Their result will be declared as "Carry Over Paper (COP)"

**9.3** The even and odd semester back paper examination will be held in even and odd semester examination respectively.

9.4 Only one opportunity would be provided to clear the back papers.

9.5 Those candidates who do not satisfy clause 9.1 and 9.2 their result will be declared as "Fail" and students will have semester back.

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#### 10. Special Back Paper Examination:

Special Back paper examination facility will be provided only for final/last year papers (second-to-last semester)

#### Result and Award of Division: 11

11.1 At the end of last semester, successful candidates will be awarded division and degree on the basis of total marks obtained (combined result) of all the semester put together as under:

a) 75% and above. First division and distinction (To be awarded to only those candidates who pass all semester examination in only one attempt)

b) 60% and above but less than 75% : First Division

c) 50% and above but less than 59,99%: Second Division

d) 40 % and above but less than 49.99%: Third Division e) Below 40%: Fail

11.2 The last (Fourth) semester project work will be assessed by grade system as per the following modified grade scale:
