**Action Taken Report on Suggestions by the Academic
Audit Committee dated 19th December 2024**

1. Recruitment drives have been initiated to fill vacant teaching and non-teaching positions.
2. Placement cells have been activated, facilitating connections between students and potential employers.
3. A framework for determining program and course outcomes is under development, involving faculty input and industry relevance.
4. Faculty members, particularly in social sciences and humanities, are receiving special support to increase research publications in reputed journals.
5. Faculty are motivated and supported by grants of seed money to submit under KUIFS Scheme with emphasis on inter-institutional and international collaborations.
6. Efforts are underway to revitalise the Alumni Association, engaging alumni in student placements and fundraising for research and development. An online Alumni meet has been conducted on 28/4/2024.
7. Short and long-term institutional development plans are being drafted, incorporating feedback from various stakeholders. Feedback analysis has been conducted by the concerned authority.
8. Initiatives have been launched to acquire additional land for the university's expansion and development needs. Under PM USHA the University has been granted a fund of 100 crores for research and expansion.
9. Faculty-led efforts are being made to publish research journals, promoting scholarly discourse and knowledge dissemination.
10. Faculty members are being encouraged to pursue interdisciplinary research endeavours, fostering cross-disciplinary collaborations.
11. Awards for outstanding readership and teaching excellence are being instituted to recognize student and faculty achievements.
12. Implementation of the 'Earn While You Learn' scheme is in progress across faculties, libraries, and guest houses, providing students with practical learning opportunities.

13. Coaching classes have been introduced to prepare students for competitive examinations, enhancing their career prospects. Library has been equipped with competitive examination books.
14. National and International Student Attraction: Marketing efforts have been intensified to attract students from across the country and abroad, showcasing the university's strengths and offerings.
15. ICT-enabled Classrooms: Expansion of ICT-enabled and smart classrooms is underway to enhance the learning experience for students.
16. Personality Development Programs: Programs focusing on personality development and communication skills enhancement are being organised for students' holistic growth.
17. Language Lab Establishment: Plans are in place to establish a language lab, facilitating language learning and proficiency improvement among students.
18. Modernization initiatives for departmental laboratories are being prioritised to ensure state-of-the-art facilities for students and researchers.
19. Guidance and support mechanisms have been established to assist students in qualifying for prestigious examinations like NET, JRF, GATE, SRF, etc. The competitive exam cell is regularly engaged in providing guidance and coaching to the students of UG and PG Program.
20. Infrastructure Accessibility: Modifications to existing infrastructure are being made to ensure accessibility for physically challenged individuals/students.
21. The IQAC is being revamped to be more proactive and effective in quality assurance and enhancement initiatives. It has incorporated effective E Governance Policy, Animal welfare Policy, Waste Management Policy and also constituted Green Committee, Energy Conservation Committee, Environment Conservation Committee
22. Faculty members are encouraged to spend dedicated hours in their departments to foster academic engagement and collaboration.
23. Collaboration efforts between relevant academic departments are underway to document, preserve, and promote Himalayan culture and traditions, with a focus on securing funding from national cultural agencies.
24. The university is actively participating in NIRF and international rankings, striving to achieve recognition as a higher educational institution of national and international importance. In the year 2023 the University got 64th rank under Pharmacy Category in NIRF and 27th in India Today ranking.
25. Efforts are being made to enhance the efficiency and outcomes of the existing Innovation and Incubation Centre, fostering entrepreneurship and innovation among students andhrafaculty.
