  - M. Sc. Pharmaceutical Biotechnology

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9. The ordinances of two programmes as mentioned in S. No. 8.(a) and S. No. 8.(b) above to be run in the centre were approved unanimously. The syllabi of the same to be prepared and drafted by the appropriate body at a later stage.
